Resolution to U.S. House of Representatives Kansas Delegation

On the position of the Kansas Republican Party concerning impeachment of President Biden and associated members of his Executive Staff.

Adopted September 30, 2023

Whereas the definition of tyranny is the cruel, unreasonable, or **arbitrary use of power or control:**

Whereas all the founding documents of this nation clearly state that tyranny is unacceptable, and to be considered a high crime when imposed;

Whereas it is mandated that the President and members of his administration are bound by oath to support the United States Constitution and prevent tyrannical conduct;

Whereas the Biden administration on 16 July, 2021, clearly colluded with members of the media communications/news establishment to deny the freedom of speech to citizens of the United States by implying that questioning the administration policy for Covid 19 vaccination was "misinformation" and should be censored;

Whereas this conduct strikes directly at the rights stated in our Constitution, it clearly indicates a blatant disregard for their oath demanded upon entry into office of and service to the United States. Though on its face it seems obvious that the people of this nation are specifically guaranteed the right to speak their opinion, this arbitrary use of power and control prevents that right. Any suppression of rights clearly undermines the "true faith and allegiance" clause of their oath and should end their service to the nation;

Be it resolved that the U.S. House of Representatives Kansas Delegation shall receive this letter of instruction and lead the case for impeachment of the President of the United States and his associated staff members based on this act of Tyranny.
